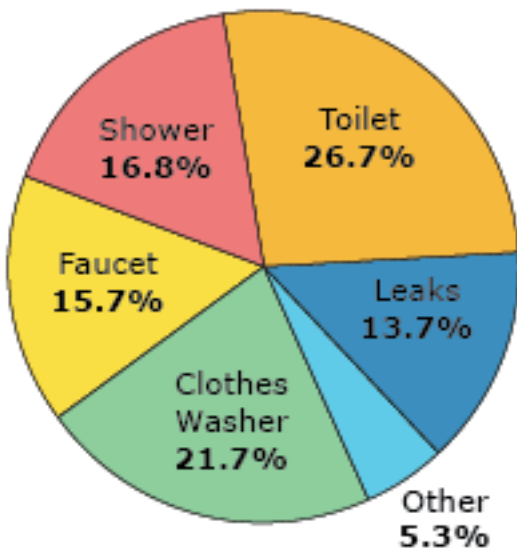

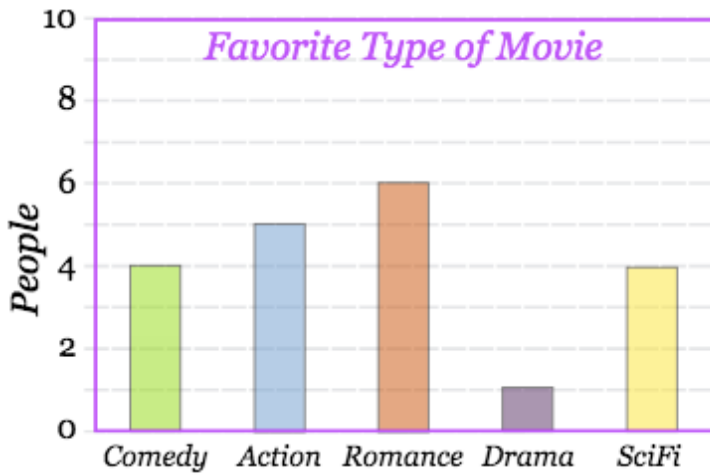
There are many different types of graphs; most frequently used graphs are:

- Pie Graph = Pie Chart

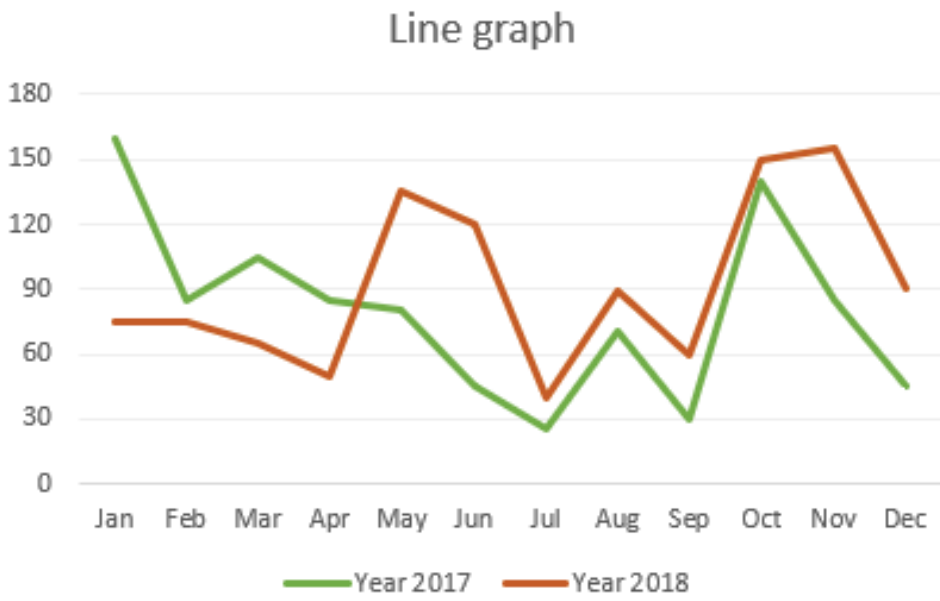
How Much Water Do We Use?



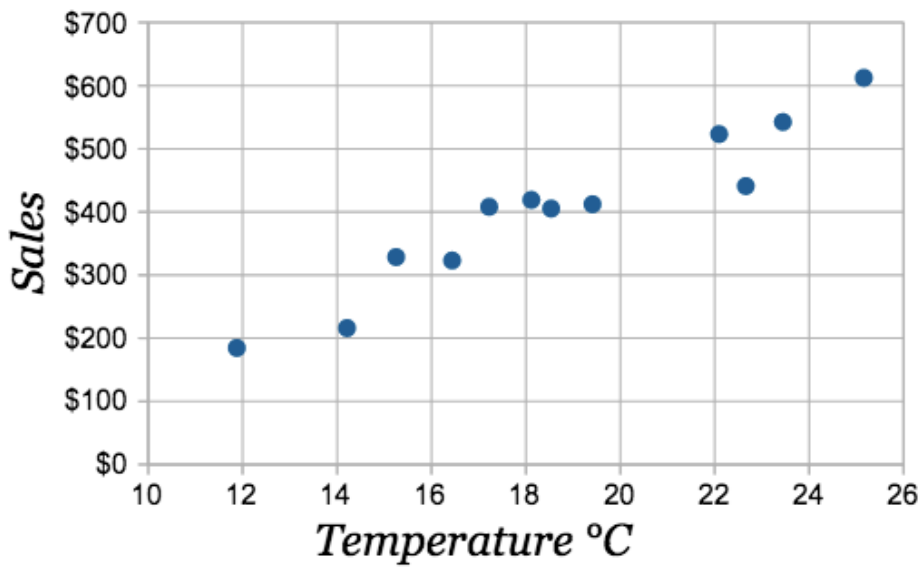
- Bar Graph



➤ Line Graph

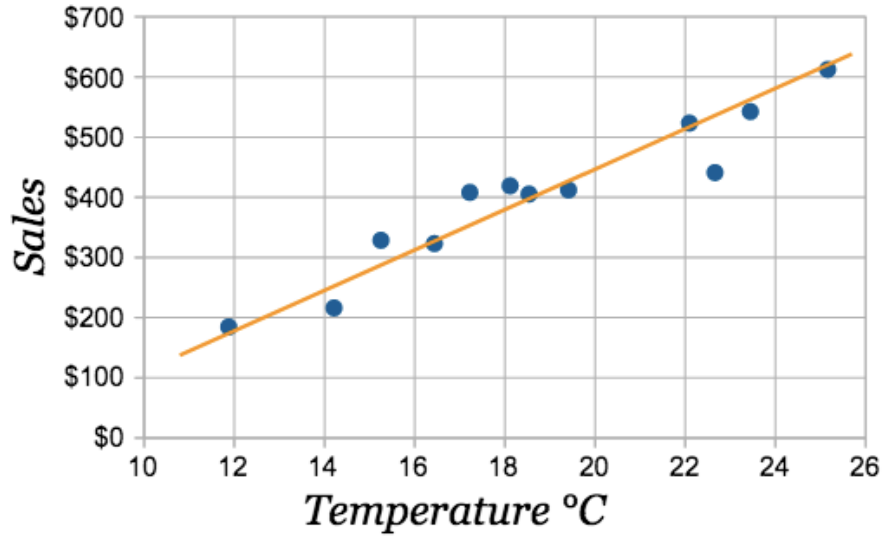


➤ Scatter Plot

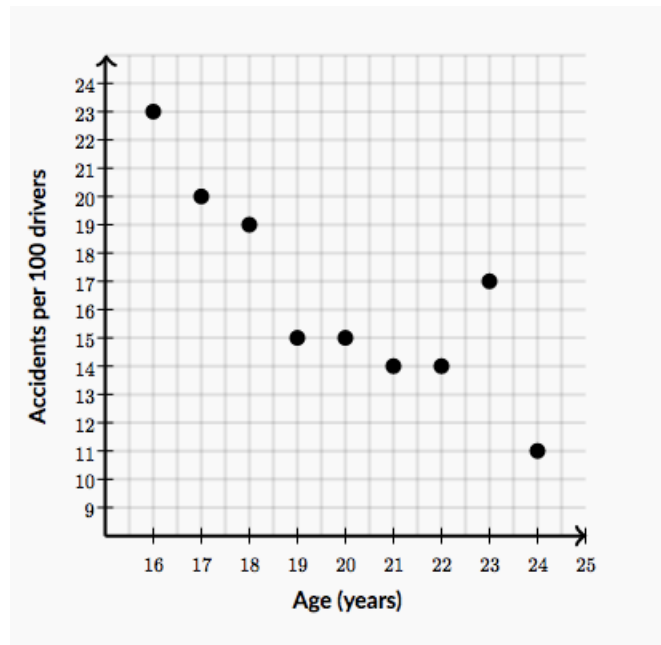


Best-Fit Line = Line of Best Fit

- A line on a graph that shows the general direction that a group of points seems to follow.
- Be careful when drawing the line of best fit, ensure that the same number of points is below the line and the same number of points is above the line if possible. A good best-fit line is “fair” to as many points as possible.

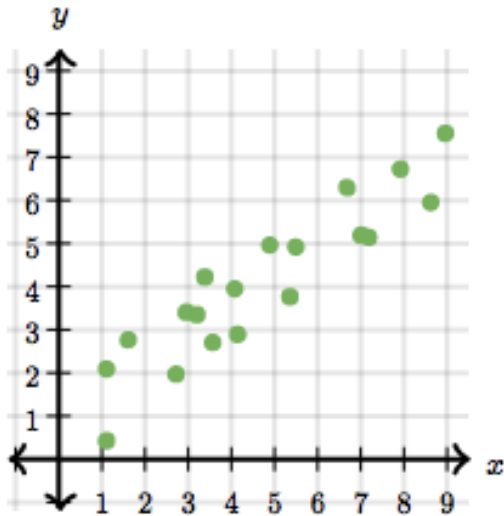

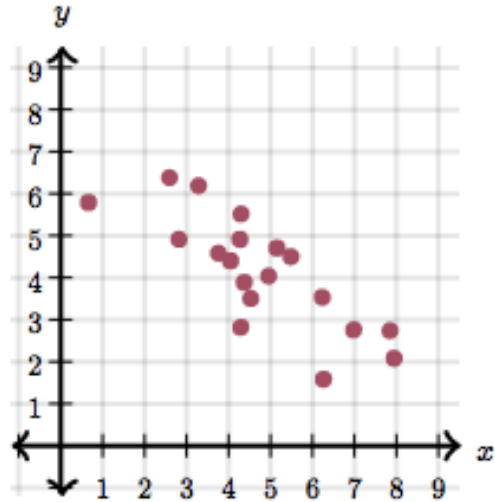


Correlation between “x” and “y” Values
